Phonaesthetics (also spelled phonesthetics in North America) is the study of beauty and pleasantness associated with the sounds of certain words or parts of words. The term was first used, perhaps by J. R. R. Tolkien in this sense, during the mid-twentieth century, deriving from the Greek: φωνή phōnē, "voice-sound" plus Greek: αἰσθητική aisthētikē, "aesthetic".
