The defence of insanity is a general defence which is available to all crimes. Where a defendant is found to be insane, the jury are directed to give a special verdict of 'not guilty by reason of insanity' under s.2 of the Trial of Lunatics Act 1883. This previously meant automatic admittance to secure accommodation. Release was only possible on authority of the Home Secretary.

(a) If a defendant pleads not guilty by reason of insanity, and also joins with it another plea or pleas, the defendant shall first be tried as if only the other plea or pleas had been entered, and in that trial the defendant shall be conclusively presumed to have been sane at the time the offense is alleged to have been committed.
