The prenatal infant at this point is called a Fetus, from the beginning of the ninth week after conception to birth, generally to the thirty-eighth week after conception or fortieth week of gestation. This Fetal Phase is characterized by rapid growth and continued tissue and organ differentiation. Viability is the time when the fetus can live outside of the womb, independently of the mother.

- The hormone estrogen may increase 100% over normal amounts before pregnancy.
- The hormone progesterone increases in pregnancy to relax the uterine muscles, preventing contractions that try and repel a foreign object - the implanting embryo.
